

Moomin clock

What's the time? If you don't know, you can use this clock to practice telling the time with an adult. You need crayons, cardboard, glue, a split pin and a pair of scissors.

1. Print out the clock sheet.
2. Colour the clock and the hands.
3. Cut out the clock and hands.
4. Glue the clock face and hands to the cardboard and cut them out.
5. Make holes in the middle of the clock and in the lower parts of the hands.
6. Slip the split pin through the holes in the clock hands and then through the hole in the clock face. Spread the ends of the pin on the reverse side and your clock is ready!

Tip! Ask an adult to put a small hole above the 12 o'clock position so that you can hang your clock on the wall!
